Children in Need

As a school, in order to collect chocolate and bottles for the event, we are holding two non-uniform days. They are as follows:

Santa's Grotto

As mentioned in the PTA Newsletter, this year children are able to visit the grotto during the school day. This will reduce the queues during the fayre and will allow a greater number of pupils to see Father Christmas.

Places are bookable via our School Gateway app. During the day, children will be accompanied by their teacher / teaching assistant, whilst in the evening parents will be able to take their children to see Father Christmas. Places are limited, so early booking is essential to avoid disappointment.

Christmas Pantomimes

In response to parental feedback, we have booked a pantomime company to come into school this year, so reducing costs at this time of year. This year's pantomime is a version of the classic tale of Cinderella and will be differentiated in terms of content for younger and older children.

The pantomimes will take place on Monday 4^{th} December. Years R,1,2 and 3 will watch the pantomime in the morning, whilst Y4,5 and 6 will watch the pantomime in the afternoon on that day. The cost of the pantomime is within a combined voluntary cost for the pantomime and party (£2.50 and £2.50 respectively, £5 in total). This is bookable on the School Gateway app.

Christmas Party Days

On the Christmas party days, pupils will need to come to school dressed in their party clothes. As mentioned above, there is a £2.50 charge for this year's party, within the £5 combined charge for the pantomime and party.

For this, children will receive snacks, a drink and party prizes, so parents do not need to provide anything further for this event. This also enables us to continue to monitor the types of snacks in school, so protecting any pupils with allergies.

Christmas Performances

Tickets for performances are now available on the School Gateway app. The hall has a maximum occupancy of 120 and so for the KS1 nativity performance, tickets are limited to 2 per family <u>at either</u> of the two performances.

We ask that performances are not recorded using mobile phones, for safeguarding reasons. School have arranged for each performance to be recorded.

On Friday 15th December (the same day as the Christmas Fayre and non-uniform day), it is Christmas jumper day. There is no charge for this day, as children are already asked to bring a bottle donation. School will make a contribution to the 'Save the Children' charity, in recognition of the children's efforts.

Christmas Items

Last year, lots of children enjoyed the Christmas items that were on sale in December (bands, pens, rings, popcorn cones etc.). This year, to ensure that items are received promptly, we will be handing out any items purchased on the school app, each Friday in December (1st, 8th and 15th December).

Items are only tokens, and price has been considered. There is no pressure upon families to purchase any of these items, but proceeds go to school fund, supporting the effective financing of our school.
