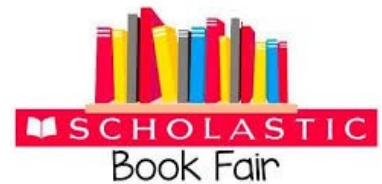


Mental Health and well-being
